In 1980 David graduated from RMIT in Chiropractic and then went on to graduate with honours in Obstetrics, Psychiatry and Paediatrics from the University of Melbourne Medical School. He was awarded the Stirling Prize for Clinical Surgery in his final year. His intern training was based at the Royal Melbourne Hospital and registrar training at Royal Melbourne, Royal Children's and Alfred Hospitals. He qualified for Fellowship of the Royal Australasian College of Surgeons in 1999. In 1999, he undertook a Spinal Fellowship at Queens Medical Centre, Nottingham England. David specializes in spinal surgery including keyhole microdiscectomy. His surgical appointments include the Epworth Hospital and the Royal Melbourne Hospital.

Lindsay Rowe is a Chiropractor, Medical Doctor, Radiologist, Educator, Author and is well known in the Chiropractic Profession. Dr Rowe received his Chiropractic degree with honours in 1979 from RMIT University in Melbourne. He subsequently qualified as a chiropractic radiologist and became Chairman, Head of Departments at Canadian Memorial Chiropractic College and North Western College of Chiropractic in Minneapolis, United States. In 1993 he graduated in Medicine in Newcastle and after extensive hospital experience qualified as a Consultant Diagnostic Radiologist in 1999 and became a Fellow in Musculoskeletal Radiology from the University of California. Since 2000, Lindsay has practised diagnostic and interventional radiology in Newcastle as Associate Professor in Radiology and Senior Staff Specialist Radiologist. During 2005 to 2008 he was involved in research upright weight bearing MRI for spinal disorders.
